The Impact of a Universal Access Playground on Our Children and Community

Universal Access Playgrounds go a step further than those that meet the basic requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. For example, ramps are wide enough for children to remain in their wheelchairs and maneuver through the playscape. The surrounding surface is soft enough to cushion a fall, yet firm enough to support mobility aids. As a result, children with disabilities have the opportunity to gain



a sense of self confidence and individuality. In turn, it gives children with and without disabilities the chance to play together, promoting social interaction. Additionally, it provides parents with disabilities the opportunity to comfortably take their children to a playground where they can supervise and interact as never before.

Our Centennial Commitment and Legacy Vision

In addition to creating the opportunity for all children to succeed, we desire to do more! We envision harnessing the creativity and leadership talent in our club and community to move forward the development and construction of state-of-the-art universal access playgrounds in other lo-

cations. This will not only help our children today, but create a new model that will help our children and children in other communities who deserve the opportunity to play together.
